

## Fireplace Mantle Assembly Instructions

**NOTE: CONSULT LOCAL BUILDING CODE REQUIREMENTS ON  
MINIMUM CLEARANCE TO COMBUSTIBLES**

<p><b>Step 1</b></p> <p>Lay mantle top and legs on soft surface (carpet, blanket, etc.). Attach legs to mantle top through predrilled holes with 3 wood screws, provided.</p>	
	<p><b>Step 2</b></p> <p>Once legs are attached, carefully set in place and center with fireplace. Take a pencil and very lightly trace down the outside of both legs onto the wall. Also, lightly trace the top of the mantle onto the wall.</p>
<p><b>Step 3</b></p> <p>Once mantle is traced to the wall, remove mantle and lay onto soft surface. From the outside leg markings on the wall, measure in 1 ¾" for the leg mounting strips. From the mantle top mark, measure down 6 ½" for the breastplate mounting strip.</p>	
	<p><b>Step 4</b></p> <p>Attach mounting strips to wall, either directly into studs or appropriate anchors. Set mantle and surround in place and attach to mounting strips using finish nails. <b>MUST PRE-DRILL BEFORE NAILING!</b></p>
<p><b>Step 5</b></p> <p>Once mantle and surround is attached, install trim around inside opening. Use nail set and wood putty to cover nail heads.</p>
